Château Ksara, Lebanon's oldest winery, was established in 1857 when Jesuit Fathers inherited the estate and began farming a 27-hectare plot of land to produce Lebanon's first non-sweet red wine. In doing so, they laid the foundations of Lebanon's modern wine industry.

It is worth mentioning, however, that they were merely continuing a 5,000 year-old trading tradition. Lebanon sits on the site of ancient Phoenicia, one of the world's oldest merchant civilizations and one of the first to sell wines to other nations.

As the country's oldest winery, its mission is to not only continue its unique, centuries-old practice of winemaking, but to also implement the newest and most innovative processes, and continue leading winemaking in Lebanon for generations to come.

*Château Ksara, la bodega más antigua del Líbano, se estableció en 1857 cuando los padres jesuitas heredaron la propiedad y comenzaron a cultivar una parcela de 27 hectáreas para producir el primer vino tinto no dulce del Líbano. Al hacerlo, pusieron las bases de la industria vitivinícola moderna del Líbano.*

*Vale la pena mencionar, sin embargo, que simplemente continuaban con una tradición comercial de 5.000 años. Líbano se encuentra en el sitio de la antigua Fenicia, una de las civilizaciones mercantiles más antiguas del mundo y una de las primeras vender vinos a otras naciones.*

*Como la bodega más antigua del país, su misión es no solo continuar con su práctica única y centenaria de elaboración del vino, sino también implementar los procesos más nuevos e innovadores y continuar liderando la elaboración del vino en el Líbano para las generaciones venideras.*

# CHATEAU KEFRAYA

UN TERROIR, UNE ÂME, UN GRAND VIN

Located in the West Bekaa Valley, the large estate of Château Kefraya has been the Bustros family's property for generations.

The castle is built starting 1946 on an artificial hill used by the Romans centuries ago to observe their troop movements. Founder and visionary Michel de Bustros undertakes massive works to implant Château Kefraya's vineyards on those magnificent hillsides.

The first vines are planted in 1951 and in 1979 – despite the Lebanese civil war (1975 – 1990) – Château Kefraya starts exporting its wines to France.

In 1997, American wine critic Robert Parker awards Comte de M 1996 a 91/100 qualifying it "An amazing accomplishment in Lebanon."

*Ubicada en el valle de West Bekaa, la gran propiedad de Château Kefraya ha sido propiedad de la familia Bustros durante generaciones.*

*El castillo se construye a partir de 1946 sobre un acolina artificial utilizada por los romanos hace siglos para observar los movimientos de sus tropas. El fundador y visionario Michel de Bustros emprende grandes obras para implantar los viñedos de Château Kefraya en esas magníficas laderas.*

*Las primeras vides se plantan en 1951 y en 1979 – a pesar de la guerra civil libanesa (1975 – 1990) – Château Kefraya comienza a exportar sus vinos a Francia.*

*En 1997, el crítico devinos estadounidense Robert Parker dio a Comte de M 1996 un 91/100 calificándolo como "Un logro asombroso en el Líbano".*

# Chateau Musar

The wines of Chateau Musar are unique expressions from a country with an ancient wine-making culture. French in origin, the Hochar family arrived in Lebanon in the 12th Century, "Preux Chevaliers," and have remained there ever since.

At 34° N of the equator, the centre of Bekaa Valley is further south than any part of Spain or Italy and as such gets its fair share of sunshine during the summer months. The Musar vineyards are situated at relatively high altitudes, (around 1000 metres above sea level) and so benefit from cool nights and seasonal temperatures (it often snows on the vines in the winter and summer can be searingly hot) resulting in longer ripening periods. Vines thrive in this pure "alpine" environment requiring little or no intervention to remain healthy.

Every wine of Chateau Musar is produced naturally with a "non-interventionist" wine-making philosophy and the winery was the first in Lebanon to implement organically certified viticulture. At harvest time, the grapes are hand-picked by Bedouins in the cool of the morning to preserve freshness, and driven in sizeable trucks over the mountains to the winery at Ghazir.

*Los vinos de Chateau Musar son expresiones únicas de un país con una antigua cultura vitivinícola. De origen francés, la familia Hochar llegó al Líbano en el siglo XII, "Preux Chevaliers", y ha permanecido allí desde entonces.*

*A 34° N del ecuador, el centro del valle de Bekaa está más al sur que cualquier parte de España o Italia y, como tal, recibe una buena cantidad de sol durante los meses de verano. Los viñedos de Musar están situados a altitudes relativamente altas (alrededor de 1000 metros sobre el nivel del mar) y, por lo tanto, se benefician de noches frescas y temperaturas estacionales (a menudo nieva en las vides en invierno y el verano puede ser muy caluroso), lo que resulta en períodos de maduración más largos. Las vides prosperan en este ambiente "alpino" puro que requiere poca o ninguna intervención para mantenerse saludable.*

*Cada vino de Chateau Musar se produce naturalmente con una filosofía de vinificación "no intervencionista" y la bodega fue la primera en el Líbano en implementar una viticultura orgánica certificada. En el momento de la cosecha, los beduinos recogen las uvas a mano en el fresco de la mañana para preservar su frescura y las transportan en grandes camiones por las montañas hasta la bodega en Ghazir.*
